



# MESSIANIC PROPHECIES

In Part 2 of the Understanding End Times Series, we discussed some of the prophecies about Messiah that Israel was foretold of. If we are going to understand the End Times, you first must understand Messiah. So this part discusses some of the prophecies that Yahusha fulfilled when He came the 1<sup>st</sup> time.

**This is a summary of the prophecies that are given in reference to our Messiah.**

- **The Messiah must be a descendant of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob**
- **The Messiah will bless all the nations of the earth**
- **He is an everlasting covenant for everyone**
- **The everlasting covenant will come from King David, being a root of Jesse, from the tribe of Judah**
- **The Messiah will be a man**
- **He will be conceived from a virgin**
- **He will come into the world as a child.**
- **His name will be called Immanuel**
- **There will be no end to His peace**
- **The government will be on His shoulders**
- **The Messiah will be anointed with the Spirit of YAHUAH**
- **The Messiah will be sinless, without deceit**
- **The Messiah will be hated by man and His nation would despise Him**
- **The Messiah will be a light to the Gentiles**
- **The Messiah will conquer death**

“When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.
