



## WHEN YAHUSHA IS KING

- He will restore the preserved ones of Israel.
- He will be a light to the Gentiles.
- He will be YAH's salvation to the ends of the earth.
- In the last days YAHUAH will raise a branch of righteousness from David.
- It will be through a King who will reign and prosper and execute judgment in the earth.
- Israel & Judah will be saved and dwell safely.
- In the days when YAHUAH saves His flock, He will establish one Shepard over them and He shall feed us.
- This servant comes from David
- When YAH makes Israel & Judah one nation again, there will be one King over them all.
- David will be King and it will be so forever. It is a covenant of peace and it's everlasting
- When He comes back with the clouds and He is given His Kingdom, all peoples, nations, and languages will serve Him.
- His dominion is everlasting and will not pass away and shall not be destroyed.
- Israel shall return and seek after their King from David.
- Every year who is left of all the nations shall go up to worship this King to keep Sukkot, the Feast of Tabernacles.
- If the families of the earth don't come up to Jerusalem Him, there will receive no rain.

But I will correct you in justice, And will not let you go altogether unpunished.’”

And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, YAHUAH of hosts, on them there will be no rain. If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which YAHUAH strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.”
