These are the biblical answers to this test. This is applying what the scriptures say without adding or fitting doctrines to justify personal beliefs. Use these answers and compare them to the answers you gave or other Christians have given you and you can review if the doctrine of Christianity is biblically sound and preparing you for what our Father plans to do in the last days

1. Who did our Father, YAHUAH (you may call "the LORD"), the Most High make the New Covenant with?

<u>The New Covenant was made with Yasharel & Yahudah (Israel & Judah) according to Jeremiah</u> 31:31-34

2. What scripture gives the covenant for Christians?

There is no Covenant for Christians

3. What does our Father plan to do in the last days before the Messiah comes back and becomes King?
