

HOW DO WE CELEBRATE PASSOVER

This is how my home was lead to remember and honor Father during the Passover. With your family partake in Yahusha's last supper. I do not call it communion and I do not add anything to it. We just do as scripture says. We take wine or grape juice (for children) and some unleavened bread. I don't really care if it is marked Kosher or not, because honestly I do not want the Rev 2:9's to be praying over my food. So we bless it ourselves. This is what we do: We share out a small amount of wine or grape juice and unleavened bread, they are referred to as Matzah's. Then the leader of the home leads:

Leader: Let us partake in the remembrance of our Savior according to His word.

The leader of the home reads Luke Chapter 22 verses 14-20

Leader: ““When the hour had come, He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him. Then He said to them, “With fervent desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of Elohim.” Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, “Take this and divide it among yourselves; for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of Elohim comes.” And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you. **Luke 22:14-20**”

1st Corinthians Chapter 11 verses 23-26 explains why we do this in remembrance of Him. “For I received from Yah that which I also delivered to you: that the Adon Yahusha on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim Adonai's death till He comes.” **1st Corinthians 11:23-26**”

So we take this bread which is a representation of our Master Yahusha's body that He gave up for us and was broken for us. We eat this in remembrance of Him. Let us eat the bread in remembrance (pause) We next take this cup which represents our Master's blood that was shed for us. This represents our covenant with Him that we are redeemed through this blood and covered by His blood. Because of His blood, our Father will pass over us. We drink this in remembrance of Yahusha. Let us drink the wine. (Pause) Now let us together pray and remember and talk to our Father.

(I normally play a song and we pray silently individually) After the song, the leader ends with prayer. I pray this helps you remember our Savior and honor our Father's day of Passover. Be blessed
