Yashar'el is YAHUAH's Chosen People

"You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself. Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."" **Exodus 19:4-6**

<u>Yashar'el would be</u>

- A special treasure to Him above all people
 - They would be a Kingdom of priests
 - A Holy Set-Apart nation.

The Abrahamic Covenant

"Now YAHUAH had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."" Genesis 12:1-3

The Purpose of Yashar'el

- The reason why YAH chose Abraham is because through Abraham's descendants He was going to solve the problem of sin for humanity.
- He also wanted Yashar'el to be His special treasure that showed the world how to worship and serve Him.
- We are to be His examples to the rest of the world.
- Being a Kingdom of Priests means we were to be the examples of how He wanted and desired to be worshipped and treated.
- YAHUAH desires us to be Set Apart to Him and to be a Kingdom of priests.
- We are to be examples of YAH's righteousness and His goodness.
- We are to be proclaimers of His Way.

Reasons for Belief in Salvation to the Gentiles

Point 1: Messiah is A Light to the Gentiles

Isaiah speaks on the Messiah multiple times being a light for the Gentiles.

""And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, Who shall stand as a banner to the people; For the Gentiles shall seek Him, And His resting place shall be glorious."" Isaiah 11:10

"""Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles." Isaiah 42:1

 ""I, YAHUAH, have called You in righteousness, And will hold Your hand;
 I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the Gentiles," Isaiah 42:6

"Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; *I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles,* That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.' " Isaiah 49:6

Matthew confirms Yahusha as being this fulfillment

"But when Yahusha knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all. Yet He warned them not to make Him known, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:
"Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased!

I will put My Spirit upon Him,

And He will declare justice to the Gentiles.

He will not quarrel nor cry out,

Nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets.

A bruised reed He will not preak,
And smoking flax He will not quench,
Till He sends forth justice to victory;

And in His name Gentiles will trust.""

They knew this prophecy!!.

Point 2: Yahusha blessed a Gentile Woman

"Then Yahusha went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Adonai, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed." But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Adonai, help me!" But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." And she said, "Yes, Adonai, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." Then Yahusha answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour."

Matthew 15:21-28

Her faith allowed her to be blessed

Point 3: Peter brings salvation to the Gentiles

Acts Chapter 10 clearly shows the Ruach HaKodesh falling upon the gentiles.

When Peter was with Cornelius he said clearly "Then he said to them, "You know how unlawful it is for a Yahudim man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But Elohim has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean. Therefore I came without objection as soon as I was sent for. I ask, then, for what reason have you sent for me?"" Acts 10:28-29

"In truth I perceive that Elohim shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him." Acts 10:34-35

"And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also." Acts 10:45

Point 4: YAHUAH Prophesied His House will be a house of prayer for all nations

"Thus says YAHUAH: "Keep justice, and do righteousness, For My salvation is about to come, And My righteousness to be revealed. Blessed is the man who does this, And the son of man who lays hold on it; Who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, And keeps his hand from doing any evil." Do not let the son of the foreigner who has joined himself to YAHUAH speak, saying, "YAHUAH has utterly separated me from His people"; Nor let the eunuch say, "Here I am, a dry tree." For thus says YAHUAH: "To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, and choose what pleases Me, And hold fast My covenant, Even to them I will give in My house and within My walls a place and a name Better than that of sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name That shall not be cut off. "Also the sons of the foreigner who join themselves to YAHUAH, to serve Him, and to love the name of YAHUAH, to be His servants-Everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, And holds fast My covenant— Even them I will bring to My holy mountain, And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on My altar; For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations." YAHUAH Elohim, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, says, "Yet I will gather to him Others besides those who are gathered to him."" Isaiah 56:1-8

> ""Many nations shall be joined to Yahuah in that day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that Yahuah of hosts has sent Me to you." Zechariah 2:11

Point 5: Salvation for All Nations shown in Book of Revelation

"Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to Elohim by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, And have made us kings and priests to our Elohim; And we shall reign on the earth.""

Revelation 5:8-10

"After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our Elohim who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"" Revelation 7:9-10

YAHUAH told us not to be concerned with the Wicked but the Righteous

And they that have loathed my Torah, while they had yet liberty, and, when as yet a place of repentance was open unto them, understood not, but despised it; The same must know it after death by pain. And therefore be not curious how the wicked shall be punished, and when: but inquire how the righteous shall be saved, whose the world is, and for whom the world is created. 2nd Esdras 9:11-14
