

Timeline for End Times Prophecy

144,000 ➡ 2 Witnesses ➡ 2nd Exodus

In Part 1 of the Timeline for End Times Prophecy, we discussed the #1 Event we should be waiting for in regards to bible prophecy. This event is the 2nd Exodus when YAHUAH gathers Yashar'el from the 4 corners of the earth where He scattered them and brings them back from captivity and they come back to their land. SUMMARY

- 1) Yashar'el rebelled and sinned against YAHUAH
- 2) Because of their sins, YAHUAH punished and scattered Yashar'el to the 4 corners of the earth
- 3) In the last days YAHUAH will gather His flock of Yashar'el where He scattered them and bring them to the wilderness where He will deal with them face to face as He did in the first exodus.

Punished & Scattered

These scriptures go over the fact that Yashar'el disobeyed YAH and were punished and then scattered to the 4 corners of the earth. You can not understand why they will be gathered from captivity if you do not understand they were punished & scattered in the 1st place

“For YAHUAH will strike Israel,
as a reed is shaken in the water.
He will uproot Israel from this good land which He gave to their fathers,
and will scatter them beyond the River,
because they have made their wooden images,
provoking YAHUAH to anger.
And He will give Israel up because of the sins of Jeroboam,
who sinned and who made Israel sin.”
1st Kings 14:15-16

“And they will fall by the edge of the sword,
and be led away captive into all nations.
And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles
until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.”
Luke 21:24

“We have acted very corruptly against You,
and have not kept the commandments, the statutes,
nor the ordinances which You commanded Your servant Moses.
Remember, I pray, the word that You commanded Your servant Moses,
saying, ‘If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations;”

Jacob's Trouble

Yashar'el was punished and exiled from their land because of disobedience,
but YAH has prophesied that He would not forget their covenant.

He knew of this before He even sent them into the land.

These verses in Deuteronomy Chapter 4 explain this

“When you beget children and grandchildren
and have grown old in the land,
and act corruptly and make a carved image in the form of anything,
and do evil in the sight of YAHUAH your Elohim to provoke Him to anger,
I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day,
that you will soon utterly perish from the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess;
you will not prolong your days in it, but will be utterly destroyed.
And YAHUAH will scatter you among the peoples,
and you will be left few in number among the nations where YAHUAH will drive you.
And there you will serve gods, the work of men's hands, wood and stone,
which neither see nor hear nor eat nor smell.
But from there you will seek YAHUAH your Elohim,
and you will find Him if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul.
When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days,
when you turn to YAHUAH your Elohim and obey His voice
(for YAHUAH your Elohim is a merciful El),
He will not forsake you nor destroy you,
nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them.”

Deuteronomy 4:25-31

He knew of this before they ever made it to the land.

He knew they were going to be punished, but He said after this distress,

Yashar'el would seek Him genuinely.

And shows this in that same prophecy when speaking about Jacob's trouble.

He explains that He will punish them and then He explains what He plans to do.

Most Christians only focus on the trouble part,

and ignore that He will be saved out of it.

The Great Tribulation is not the trouble,

but the time where YAH will save Jacob out of the trouble

He allowed to happen to them.

The verses in Jeremiah 30 explain

Now these are the words that YAHUAH spoke concerning Israel and Judah.”

““For thus says YAHUAH: ‘

We have heard a voice of trembling,
Of fear, and not of peace.

Ask now, and see, Whether a man is ever in labor with child?
So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins Like a woman in labor,
And all faces turned pale?

Alas! For that day is great, So that none is like it;

AND IT IS THE TIME OF JACOB’S TROUBLE,

But he shall be saved out of it.

‘For it shall come to pass in that day,’ Says YAHUAH of hosts,

‘That I will break his yoke from your neck,

And will burst your bonds;

Foreigners shall no more enslave them.

But they shall serve YAHUAH their Elohim,

And David their king, whom I will raise up for them.

‘Therefore do not fear, O My servant Jacob,’ says YAHUAH,

‘Nor be dismayed, O Israel;

For behold, I will save you from afar,

And your seed from the land of their captivity.

Jacob shall return, have rest and be quiet,

And no one shall make him afraid.

For I am with you,’ says YAHUAH, ‘to save you;

Though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you,

Yet I will not make a complete end of you.

But I will correct you in justice, And will not let you go altogether unpunished.’

“For thus says YAHUAH: ‘Your affliction is incurable, Your wound is severe.

There is no one to plead your cause, that you may be bound up;

You have no healing medicines.

All your lovers have forgotten you;

They do not seek you;

For I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy,

With the chastisement of a cruel one,

For the multitude of your iniquities,

Because your sins have increased.

Why do you cry about your affliction?

Your sorrow is incurable.

Because of the multitude of your iniquities,

Because your sins have increased,

I have done these things to you.”

2nd Exodus

When Jacob is saved out of the trouble YAHUAH sends to Him,
He is prophesied to be regathered from the 4 corners of the earth.
The 2nd Exodus is the event where YAH brings Jacob out of captivity
where He scattered them

"But I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries
where I have driven them,
and bring them back to their folds;
and they shall be fruitful and increase.

I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them;
and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed,
nor shall they be lacking," says YAHUAH.

"Behold, the days are coming," says YAHUAH,
"That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness;
A King shall reign and prosper,

And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

In His days Judah will be saved,
And Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called:
YAHUAH OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

"Therefore, behold, the days are coming," says YAHUAH,
"that they shall no longer say,

'As YAHUAH lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt,'
but, 'As YAHUAH lives who brought up and led the descendants of the house of Israel
from the north country and from all the countries where I had driven them.'
And they shall dwell in their own land.'"

144,000

We don't know exactly when the 2nd Exodus will start,
but we know he will seal the 144,000 first and
this won't happen before at least the first 4 seals are opened,
so that's peace being taken from the earth (ww3, civil wars etc.),
then famine and inflation (dollar collapse and reset of fiat money),
and then ¼ of the population goes.

We can expect that the 2nd exodus won't happen
before this point because of what is said in Revelation 7

"After these things I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth,
holding the four winds of the earth,
that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree.
Then I saw another angel ascending from the east,
having the seal of the living Elohim.
And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted
to harm the earth and the sea, saying,
"Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till
we have sealed the servants of our Elohim on their foreheads.""

Revelation 7:1-3

In this video I explained that I can see a situation where the 2nd Exodus happens during the time
of the 5th Trumpet when the world is dealing with the plague from the locusts, but the sealed of
Yashar'el are not affected and able to move freely for 5 months. This is what is written.

"Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth.
And to them was given power,
as the scorpions of the earth have power.
They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth,
or any green thing, or any tree,
but only those men who do not have the seal of Elohim on their foreheads.
And they were not given authority to kill them,
but to torment them for five months.
Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man."

Revelation 9:3-5

2 Witnesses

When the 2 witnesses come we will receive more clarity
because it is said they will prophesy for 1260 days.

**"And I will give power to my two witnesses,
and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."**

These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the Elohim of the earth.

And if anyone wants to harm them,
fire proceeds from their mouth and devours their enemies.
And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner.

These have power to shut heaven,
so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy;
and they have power over waters to turn them to blood,
and to strike the earth with all plagues, as often as they desire.

When they finish their testimony,
the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them,
overcome them, and kill them.

And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city
which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt,
where also our Adon was crucified.

Then those from the peoples, tribes, tongues, and nations
will see their dead bodies three-and-a-half days,
and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves.

And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them,
make merry, and send gifts to one another,
because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth."

Revelation 11:3-10

What's Prophesied in Revelation 11 aligns with what is written in Zechariah 4

"Then I answered and said to him,
"What are these two olive trees—
at the right of the lampstand and at its left?"

And I further answered and said to him,
"What are these two olive branches that drip into the receptacles
of the two gold pipes from which the golden oil drains?"

Then he answered me and said,
"Do you not know what these are?"

And I said, "No, my Adonai" So he said,

**"These are the two anointed ones,
who stand beside the Adonai of the whole earth."**
