

PRAYER OF REPENTANCE TO YAHUAH

WE WANT TO GO HOME

“If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves,
and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways,
then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

2nd Chronicles 7:14

In my video when I spoke about my problem, Yahuah gave me the answer and it included the remnant. The remnant is the answer. We must do as Yahuah has asked of us. We must repent and accept our guilt. In this video I covered what Yahuah proclaimed in Leviticus Chapter 26 and if every one of the remnant truly does what Yahuah has asked, I believe it will mark a significant shift in the spiritual realm and Yahuah will remember us as a whole.

This is what is written in Leviticus 26

“But if they confess their iniquity and the iniquity of their fathers,
with their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me,
and that they also have walked contrary to Me,
and that I also have walked contrary to them
and have brought them into the land of their enemies;
if their uncircumcised hearts are humbled, and they accept their guilt—
then I will remember My covenant with Jacob,
and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham I will remember;
I will remember the land.

The land also shall be left empty by them,
and will enjoy its sabbaths while it lies desolate without them;
they will accept their guilt,
because they despised My judgments and because their soul abhorred My statutes.

Yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies,
I will not cast them away, nor shall I abhor them, to utterly destroy them
and break My covenant with them;
for I am Yahuah their Elohim.

But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors,
whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations,
that I might be their Elohim:
I am YAHUAH.’ ”

These are the statutes and judgments and laws which YAHUAH made between Himself
and the children of Israel on Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.”

Leviticus 26:40-46

THE PRAYER

I know and understand that because of this iniquity from myself and my ancestors, You understandably and rightfully turned Your back against us, and this is why we were brought into this wicked land of our enemies.

Father Yahuah, You said that if we repent, humble ourselves, circumcise our hearts, and accepted our guilt— then You will remember the covenant You made with Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob and You will remember the land.

Father Yahuah, I accept your gift of redemption and remission of sin through sending your Son Yahusha to be the ultimate atonement for our sins, so that our sins are remembered no more. I accept Yahusha as our atonement. I thank you for the grace that You provide that you did not have to give.

Yahuah, I come to you in the name of Your Son, Yahusha the Messiah, and I ask that You remember Your people and remember Your covenant you made with Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob and You remember the land. You said you will not break the covenant You made with our forefathers and I ask You to remember us in this land of our enemies and deliver us and bring us back home. Your people desire to come back to You.

I love You, I trust You, I submit to Your will, and I thank You YAHUAH. May You be praised and honor all the days of my life. Remember us YAHUAH!
