

WHEN THE WORD “BAPTISMA” WAS USED

In part 11 as I explained the lie that Christianity created with the word baptize, I used John MacArthur to illustrate the lie. He lied and said every time you see the word baptism used in the book of Acts, it refers to **a person who is confessing Christ being immersed fully into water.**

This is a lie and I have collected all the times that the word baptism is used in the New Testament, not just from the book of Acts and I want it to be understood that the majority of the times you see the word “baptism” it is in reference to the Baptism of John especially in Acts. The evidence is put before you so that you can go through all the instances and see for yourself.

Matthew 3:7 - Baptism of John

“But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his **baptism**, he said to them, “Brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?”

Matthew 20:22 - Immersion in Death

“But Yahusha answered and said, “You do not know what you ask.
Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink,
and be baptized with the **baptism** that I am baptized with?”
They said to Him, “We are able.””

Matthew 20:23 - Immersion in Death

“So He said to them,
“You will indeed drink My cup, and be baptized with the **baptism** that I am baptized with;
but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give,
but it is for those for whom it is prepared by My Father.””

Matthew 21:25 - Baptism of John

“The **baptism** of John—where was it from?
From heaven or from men?”
And they reasoned among themselves, saying,
“If we say, ‘From heaven,’ He will say to us,
‘Why then did you not believe him?’”

Mark 1:4 - Baptism of John

“John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a **baptism** of repentance for the remission of sins.”

Mark 10:38 - Immersion in Death

“But Yahusha said to them,
“You do not know what you ask.
Are you able to drink the cup that I drink,
and be baptized with the **baptism** that I am baptized with?””

Mark 10:39 - Immersion in Death

“They said to Him, “We are able.”
So Yahusha said to them, “You will indeed drink the cup that I drink,
and with the **baptism** I am baptized with you will be baptized;”

Mark 11:30 - Baptism of John

“The **baptism** of John—was it from heaven or from men? Answer Me.””

Luke 3:3 - Baptism of John

“And he went into all the region around the Jordan,
preaching a **baptism** of repentance for the remission of sins,”

Luke 7:29 – Baptism of John

“And when all the people heard Him, even the tax collectors justified Elohim,
having been baptized with the **baptism** of John.”

Luke 12:50 – Immersed in Death

“But I have a **baptism** to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!

”

Luke 20:4 – Baptism of John

“The **baptism** of John—was it from heaven or from men?””

Now MacArthur said that every instance in the book of Acts when Baptism is used, it refers to a person who is confessing Christ being immersed fully into water

That was a direct lie.
All of the instances in Acts refer to the Baptism of John
Here is the Proof

Acts 1:22 - Baptism of John

“beginning from the **baptism** of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection.””

Acts 10:37 - Baptism of John

“that word you know, which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the **baptism** which John preached.””

Acts 13:24 – Baptism of John

“after John had first preached, before His coming, the **baptism** of repentance to all the people of Israel.””

Acts 18:25 - Baptism of John

“This man had been instructed in the way of the Adon; and being fervent in spirit, he spoke and taught accurately the things of the Adon, though he knew only the **baptism** of John.””

Acts 19:3 – Baptism of John

“And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?”
So they said, “Into John’s **baptism.**””

Acts 19:4 – Baptism of John

“Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a **baptism** of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Messiah Yahusha.””

Romans 6:4 – Immersion in Death

“Therefore we were buried with Him through **baptism** into death, that just as Messiah was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

Ephesians 4:5 – Immersed into One Body

“one Adon, one faith, one **baptism**;”

Colossians 2:12 - Immersion in Death

“buried with Him in **baptism**, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of Elohim, who raised Him from the dead.”

1st Peter 3:21 – Immersion in Death

“There is also an antitype which now saves us—**baptism**
(not the removal of the filth of the flesh,
but the answer of a good conscience toward Elohim),
through the resurrection of Yahusha the Messiah,”
