**Our Father in Heaven is in covenant with Israel & Judah**

“Behold, the days are coming, says Yahuah, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says Yahuah.

But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says Yahuah:

I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.”

**Jeremiah 31:31-33**

*Also can be found in Hebrews 8:8-12*

### **Question #2 - Does the identity of the children of Israel matter today?**

**Yes, the identity of Israel matters because of bible prophecy**

Everything that our Father will be doing in the end times is about the Children of Israel.

The seals, bowls, and judgments in the book of revelation are about Israel.

The same way the plagues happened in Egypt in the 1<sup>st</sup> Exodus, the judgments in Revelation are paralleled to this.

If you don't know what our Father is going to do, this is a reason why you can be deceived by the enemy. And this is why you wouldn't be ready for our Father.

and one king shall be king over them all; they shall no longer be two nations,  
nor shall they ever be divided into two kingdoms again.

They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols,  
nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions;

holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times.”

**Leviticus 23:4**

*The whole Chapter of Leviticus 23 reviews each feast*

It is prophesied in Jubilees why Israel was rejected. One reason is they forgot Yahuah's feasts.

And do you write for yourself all these words which I declare unto you this day,

**for I know their rebellion and their stiff neck,**

before I bring them into the land of which I swore to their fathers,

to Avraham and to Yitschaq and to Ya'aqov, saying:

Unto your seed will I give a land flowing with milk and honey.

And they will eat and be satisfied, and they will turn to strange elohim,

to elohim which cannot deliver them from ought of their tribulation:

and this witness shall be heard for a witness against them.

**For they will forget all my commandments, even all that I command them,**

**and they will walk after the other nations, and after their uncleanness,**

**and after their shame, and will serve their elohim,**

and these will prove unto them an offence and a tribulation and an affliction and a snare.

And many will perish and they will be taken captive,

**and will fall into the hands of the enemy,**

**because they have forsaken my ordinances and my commandments,**

**and the feasts of my covenant, and my Sabbaths,**

and my holy place which I have sanctified for myself in their midst,

and my Tabernacle, and my sanctuary,

which I have sanctified for myself in the midst of the land,

that I should set my name upon it, and that it should dwell there.

**Jubilees 1:8-11**

In the Millennial Kingdom, we will be celebrating Sukkot with Yahusha and the survivors of the other nations that do not come to worship with Yahuah will be rejected and not receive rain.

So if you believe you will be in the Kingdom,  
you should be a part of it now and celebrate His feasts.

“And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, Yahuah of hosts,

**and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.**

**And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahuah of hosts, on them there will be no rain.**

If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain;

they shall receive the plague with which Yahuah strikes the nations

**who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.**

This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all

**the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.”**

**Zechariah 14:16-19**

## Why we don't keep pagan holidays

- We are told to not learn the way of the other nations

“Hear the word which Yahuah speaks to you, O house of Israel.

**Thus says Yahuah: “Do not learn the way of the Gentiles;**

Do not be dismayed at the signs of heaven,

For the Gentiles are dismayed at them.

For the customs of the peoples are futile;

**For one cuts a tree from the forest,**

**The work of the hands of the workman, with the ax.**

**They decorate it with silver and gold;**

They fasten it with nails and hammers so that it will not topple.”

**Jeremiah 10:1-4**

- We are told not to beware of the traditions of men

**“Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit,**

**According to the tradition of men,**

**according to the basic principles of the world,**

**and not according to Messiah.”**

**Colossians 2:8**

- Most importantly we are called to be Set Apart and Holy unto Yahuah only

**And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’**

These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.”

**Exodus 19:6**

**And you shall be holy men to Me:**

you shall not eat meat torn by beasts in the field;

you shall throw it to the dogs.

**Exodus 22:31**

**“For I am YAHUAH your Elohim.**

**You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I am holy.**

Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” “

For I am YAHUAH who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your Elohim.

**You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.**

**Leviticus 11:44-45**

**“And you shall be holy to Me, for I Yahuah am holy,  
and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine.”**

## **Question #4 - Do you believe the whole Torah was done away with?**

**No, the Torah is still to be kept except for what changed in the Law**

The Torah has not been done away with. Our Messiah said

“Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets.  
I did not come to destroy but to fulfill.  
For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away,  
one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.  
Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments,  
and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven;  
but whoever does and teaches them,  
he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.  
For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds  
the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees,  
you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.”  
Matthew 5:17-20

**We are not under what changed from the Law and that is about atonement.**

**We have a New High Priest and a New Priestly Order**

“Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens,  
Yahusha the Son of Elohim, let us hold fast our confession.  
For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses,  
but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.”  
Hebrews 4:14-15

“So also Messiah did not glorify Himself to become High Priest,  
but it was He who said to Him:  
“You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.”  
As He also says in another place:  
“You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek”;  
Hebrews 5:5-6

**We no longer atone through the Levitical Priesthood  
with the sacrifice of goats and rams,  
but we are now atoned through the blood of Yahusha as our final atonement.**

“Previously saying,  
“Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings,  
and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them”  
(which are offered according to the law),  
then He said,  
“Behold, I have come to do Your will, O Elohim.”  
He takes away the first that He may establish the second.  
By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of  
the body of Yahusha the Messiah once for all.”  
Hebrews 10:8-10

**The rest of the Torah is still valid and to be kept  
except how we atone and where the Law is now written.  
Instead of stone tablets, it’s now written on our hearts**

“For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel  
after those days, says Yahuah:  
I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts;  
and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.”  
Hebrews 8:10

**Sin is transgression of the Torah**

Whosoever commits sin transgresses also the Torah:  
for sin is the transgression of the Torah  
1 John 3:4

**Question #5 - Do you believe the Commandments our Father declared in the Old Testament are still to be kept?**

**Yes, I believe we are to keep the commandments**

*See Matthew 5:17-20 above*

Whoever teaches men to break one of these commandments will be considered least in the kingdom. He said if your righteousness doesn't exceed the righteousness of the scribes and pharisees you will by no means enter the Kingdom. The scribes and pharisees absolutely kept the Law, their problem is their heart was not circumcised and they added traditions of men to it.

**“If you love Me, keep My commandments.”**

**John 14:15**

**Whoever commits sin transgresses also the Torah:  
for sin is the transgression of the Torah.**

And you know that he was manifested to take away our sins;  
and in him is no sin.

**Whoever abides in him sins not:**

**whoever sins, has not seen him, neither known him.**

Little children, let no man deceive you:

he that does righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

**He that commits sin is of the devil, for the devil sins from the beginning.**

For this purpose the Son of Elohim was manifested,  
that he might destroy the works of the devil.

**1 John 3:4-8**

# YOU MUST LOVE YAHUAH!!!

“Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him,  
“Which is the first commandment of all?”  
Yahusha answered him,  
“The first of all the commandments is:  
‘Hear, O Israel, Yahuah our Elohim, Yahuah is one.  
And you shall love Yahuah your Elohim with all your heart,  
with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’  
This is the first commandment.  
And the second, like it, is this:  
‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’  
There is no other commandment greater than these.”  
Mark 12:28-31

**And our Father has made it clear how you are to love Him**

““And now, Israel, what does Yahuah your Elohim require of you,  
but to fear Yahuah your Elohim,  
to walk in all His ways and to love Him,  
to serve Yahuah your Elohim with all your heart and with all your soul,  
and to keep the commandments of Yahuah and His statutes  
which I command you today for your good?”  
Deuteronomy 10:12-13

““See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil,  
in that I command you today to love Yahuah your Elohim,  
to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments, His statutes,  
and His judgments, that you may live and multiply;  
and Yahuah your Elohim will bless you in the land which you go to possess.”  
Deuteronomy 30:15-16

This is His standard. This is how we love Him.  
To walk in His ways and keep His commandments, statutes, and judgments.  
So whatever doctrine you are applying that tells you to not keep the commandments,  
it's a doctrine of demons and it will have you rejected when you stand before Him.  
The greatest commandment is to love our Father.

## **Question #6 - Who is the God you serve?**

**Yahuah (YHWH)**

**This is how He introduced Himself to the world through Moses**

“Moreover Elohim said to Moses,  
“Thus you shall say to the children of Israel:  
Yahuah Elohai of your fathers,  
the Elohai of Abraham, the Elohai of Isaac,  
and the Elohai of Jacob, has sent me to you.  
This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.”  
Exodus 3:15

The Shema of Israel is highly important to this faith .

**Hear, O Israel:  
Yahuah our Elohim,  
Yahuah is one!  
You shall love Yahuah your Elohim with all your heart,  
with all your soul, and with all your strength.  
Deuteronomy 6:4&5**

**Now therefore fear Yahuah and serve him in sincerity and in truth:**  
and put away the elohim which your fathers served on the other side of the flood,  
and in Egypt; and serve ye Yahuah.  
And if it seems evil unto you to serve Yahuah,  
choose you this day whom ye will serve;  
whether the elohai which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood,  
or the elohim of the Ammorites in whose land you dwell:  
**but as for me and my house,  
we will serve Yahuah.**  
Joshua 24:14-15

## Question #7 - What is the end time prophecy you are waiting for?

I'm waiting for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Exodus

“But I will gather the remnant of My flock out of all countries where I have driven them, and bring them back to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase.

I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking,” says YAHUAH.

“Behold, the days are coming,” says YAHUAH,

“That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness;

A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely;

Now this is His name by which He will be called: YAHUAH OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

“Therefore, behold, the days are coming,” says YAHUAH,

“that they shall no longer say,

‘As YAHUAH lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt,’

but, ‘As YAHUAH lives who brought up and led the descendants of the house of Israel from the north country and from all the countries where I had driven them.’

And they shall dwell in their own land.””

Jeremiah 23:3-8

“As I live,” says YAHUAH Elohim,

“surely with a mighty hand, with an outstretched, and with fury poured out, I will rule over you.

I will bring you out from the peoples and gather you out of the countries where you are scattered, with a mighty hand, with an outstretched arm, and with fury poured out.

And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there I will plead My case with you face to face.

Just as I pleaded My case with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so I will plead My case with you,” says YAHUAH Elohim.

“I will make you pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant;

I will purge the rebels from among you, and those who transgress against Me;

It has not happened yet and this prophecy in Ezekiel shows what anyone should be waiting for to verify this biblically

Again the word of YAHUAH came to me, saying,  
“As for you, son of man, take a stick for yourself and write on it:  
‘For Judah and for the children of Israel, his companions.’  
Then take another stick and write on it,  
‘For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Israel, his companions.’  
Then join them one to another for yourself into one stick,  
and they will become one in your hand.  
“And when the children of your people speak to you, saying,  
‘Will you not show us what you mean by these?’— say to them,  
‘Thus says Adonai YAHUAH:

“Surely I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim,  
and the tribes of Israel, his companions;  
and I will join them with it, with the stick of Judah,  
and make them one stick, and they will be one in My hand.” ’

And the sticks on which you write will be in your hand before their eyes.”

““Then say to them, ‘Thus says Adonai YAHUAH:

“Surely I will take the children of Israel from among the nations,  
wherever they have gone,  
and will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land;  
and I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel;  
and one king shall be king over them all; they shall no longer be two nations,  
nor shall they ever be divided into two kingdoms again.  
They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols,  
nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions;

‘Therefore do not fear, O My servant Jacob,’ says YAHUAH,  
‘Nor be dismayed, O Israel;

**No, There is no biblical promise for us to go to heaven**

Actual promise to Abraham in the Abrahamic Covenant

And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, Yahuah appeared to Abram, and said unto him: I am El Shaddai; walk before me, and be perfect. And I will make my covenant between me and you and will multiply you exceedingly. And Abram fell on his face: and Elohim talked with him, saying: As for me, behold, my covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations.

Neither shall your name anymore be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made you. And I will make you exceedingly fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come out of you. And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your seed after you in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be Elohim unto you, and to your seed after you. And I will give unto you, and to your seed after you the land wherein you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession;

and I will be their Elohim. And Elohim said unto Abraham:

You shall guard my covenant therefore, you, and your seed after you in their generations.

Genesis 17:1-9

This is how it all ends.

**“Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth,

Also there was no more sea.

but to dwell on earth that our Father created in peace**

**Question #10 - Do you practice the ineffable name doctrine and believe our  
Father's name is not important?**

**No, I do not believe in the Ineffable Name Doctrine and I believe we should call on His name**

The Ineffable Name Doctrine is doctrine that comes from modern day Judaism  
that has told us that our Father's name is too holy to be said.

This doctrine has been a huge part to the misunderstanding of our Father  
and unfortunately is unknown to many.

The reason why we use the title “the Lord” is not  
because of simple English translation,  
but it is because of modern Judaism.

**Every time you see “The LORD” written in your Bibles,  
His actual name was written in the  
Hebrew Characters of the Tetragrammaton,  
YAHUAH  
Every time you see “The LORD” they were saying His name**

**You shall not take the name of YAHUAH your Elohim in vain;  
for YAHUAH will not hold him guiltless that takes his name in vain."**

**Exodus 20:7**

**I am YAHUAH: that is my name:  
and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images."**

**Isaiah 42:8**

## **We must call on Him and praise Him**

**"Oh, magnify YAHUAH with me, And let us exalt His name together."**

**Psalms 34:3**

**"I will praise YAHUAH according to His righteousness,
