

WHO IS YAHUSHA?

This conversation should not start before you explain Yahuah first and making sure that the person you are talking to, truly knows Yahuah, The God of Israel. You should never talk about Yahusha with anyone until you know for certain that the person understands the God of Israel.

They must know the Shema. That must be the foundation

Never speak about Yahusha with anyone if they do not know Yahuah first

Yahusha is Prophesied to be Yahuah’s Servant

We know He is:

- The Chosen Servant,
- The Obedient Servant,
- The Suffering Servant,
- The servant called to
 - Raise up Jacob
 - Restore the preserved ones of Israel
 - Be a light to the Gentiles.

THE CHOSEN SERVANT

Behold my Servant, whom I uphold;
my Elect One, in whom my soul delights;
I have put my Ruach upon him;
he shall bring forth judgment to the other nations.
He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.
A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench:
he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.
He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he has set judgment in the earth:
and the isles shall wait for his Torah.
Thus says the El Yahuah, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out;
he that spread forth the earth, and that which comes out of it;
he that gives breath unto the people upon it,
and ruach to them that walk therein:
I Yahuah have called you in righteousness,
and will hold your hand, and will keep you,
and give you for a covenant of the people,
for a light of the other nations;
To open the blind eyes,
to bring out the prisoners from the prison,
and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.
I am Yahuah: that is my name:
and my glory will I not give to another,
neither my praise to graven images.
“Behold, the former things have come to pass,
And new things I declare; Before they spring forth I tell you of them.””

- **He is Yahuah’s Servant, His Elect One** (Isaiah 42:1)
- **He is not Yahuah. Also He is Elected by Yahuah** (Isaiah 42:1)

just as the Son of Man did not come to be served,
but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.””

- **Yahuah said He is going to put His Ruach upon Him** (Isaiah 42:1)

Yahusha came up immediately from the water;

and He saw the Spirit of Elohim descending
like a dove and alighting upon Him.”

for Elohim does not give the Spirit by measure.

- **He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street.**
(Isaiah 42:2)

“But when Yahusha knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all. **Yet He warned them not to make Him known**, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, And He will declare justice to the Gentiles. He will not quarrel nor cry out, Nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench, Till He sends forth justice to victory; And in His name Gentiles will trust.””

**Yahusha told the multitudes who followed Him to keep it on the hush.
He did not come screaming out who He was**

- **He called Him in righteousness** (Isaiah 42:6)

This is what is continuously spoken of him like Peter in Acts 3

“My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin.
And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Yahusha the Messiah the righteous.”

- **He is given as a covenant to the people** (Isaiah 42:6)

“For this is My blood of the new covenant,
which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”

- **He is given for a light to the other nations** (Isaiah 42:6)

“So he came by the Spirit into the temple. And when the parents brought in the Child Yahusha, to do for Him according to the custom of the law, he took Him up in his arms and blessed Elohim and said: “Yahuah, now You are letting Your servant depart in peace, According to Your word; For my eyes have seen Your salvation Which You have prepared before the face of all peoples, **A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles,** And the glory of Your people Israel.””

The Obedient Servant

“Yahuah Elohim has given Me the tongue of the learned,
That I should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary.

Nor did I turn away.
I gave My back to those who struck Me,

2nd Passage

"Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high.

Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man,
 And His form more than the sons of men; So shall He sprinkle many nations.

Kings shall shut their mouths at Him; For what had not been told them they shall see,
 And what they had not heard they shall consider." "Who has believed our report?

And to whom has the arm of Yahuah been revealed?

For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground.

He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him,

There is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men,

A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him;

He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows;

Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by Elohim, and afflicted.

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities;

The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

All we like sheep have gone astray;

We have turned, every one, to his own way; And Yahuah has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth;

He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent,

So He opened not His mouth.

He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation?

For He was cut off from the land of the living;

For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

And they made His grave with the wicked— But with the rich at His death,

Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth.

Yet it pleased Yahuah to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief.

When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed,

He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of Yahuah shall prosper in His hand.

He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied.

By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong,

Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors,

And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors."

Isaiah 52:13 - 53:12

- **His Servant shall deal prudently** (Isaiah 52:13)

There is not one scripture that can capture this.
 This points to Yahusha's complete ministry, His perfect obedience to Yahuah's will,
 and His sacrificial death on the cross
 (a moment that appears humiliating but is biblically defined as the ultimate act of wisdom)

- **He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high** (Isaiah 52:13)

“And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore Elohim also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Yahusha every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Yahusha the Messiah is Adon, to the glory of Elohim the Father.”

Philippians 2:8-11

- **He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.** (Isaiah 53:3)

“Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.
 And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him,
 put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.”

“Then He took the twelve aside and said to them,
 “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished. For He will be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon.

- **He was cut off from the land of the living** (Isaiah 53:8)

- **For the transgressions of My people He was stricken. And they made His grave with the wicked** (Isaiah 53:8-9)

“Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Yahusha. This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Yahusha. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him. When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.”

- **And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors** (Isaiah 53:12)

The Servant called to Raise up Jacob, Restore the preserved ones of Israel, & be a Light to the Gentiles

“Listen, O coastlands, to Me, And take heed, you peoples from afar!

Yahuah has called Me from the womb;

From the matrix of My mother He has made mention of My name.

And He has made My mouth like a sharp sword;

In the shadow of His hand He has hidden Me,

And made Me a polished shaft; In His quiver He has hidden Me.”

“And He said to me,

‘You are My servant, O Israel, In whom I will be glorified.’

Then I said,

‘I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nothing and in vain;

Yet surely my just reward is with Yahuah,

And my work with my Elohim.’ ”

“And now Yahuah says,

Who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant,

To bring Jacob back to Him,

So that Israel is gathered to Him

(For I shall be glorious in the eyes of Yahuah, And My Elohim shall be My strength),

To raise up the tribes of Jacob,

And to restore the preserved ones of Israel;

I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles,

That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.’ ””

- **Yahuah has called Him from the womb** (Isaiah 49:1)
- **From the matrix of His mother He has made mention of His name** (Isaiah 49:1)

“And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son,
and shall call His name Yahusha.”

- **He has made His mouth like a sharp sword** (Isaiah 49:2)

“He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword,
and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.”
