Yahuah is His name

“Thus you shall say to the children of Israel:

‘Yahuah

Elohai of your fathers, the Elohai of Abraham,
the Eloahi of Isaac, and the Elohai of Ya’aqov, has sent me to you.

This is My name forever,

and this is My memorial to all generations.

Exodus 3:15

I am Yahuah: that is my name:

and my glory will I not give to another,
neither my praise to graven images.

Isaiah 42:8

His name was written almost 6000 times in the Old Testament before the translators practiced the Ineffable Name Doctrine and replaced it with “The Lord”.

When you call Him “The Lord” you are practicing the Ineffable Name Doctrine

His name is a part of our commands to keep.
We are commanded to not take His name in vain

**““You shall not take the name of YAHUAH your Elohim in vain,
for YAHUAH will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.”**

Exodus 20:7

Our mission must be to keep the Greatest Commandment

The Shema of Israel

*“Hear, O Israel:
Yahuah our Elohim, Yahuah is one!
You shall love Yahuah your Elohim
with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
Deuteronomy 6:4-5*

This is how important it is.

And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart.
You shall teach them diligently to your children,
and shall talk of them when you sit in your house,
when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
You shall bind them as a sign on your hand,
and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.
You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”

Deuteronomy 6:6-9

How do we love Yahuah?

*“And now, Israel, what does Yahuah your Elohim require of you,
but to fear Yahuah your Elohim,
to walk in all His ways and to love Him,
to serve Yahuah your Elohim with all your heart and with all your soul,
and to keep the commandments of Yahuah and His statutes
which I command you today for your good?”*

Deuteronomy 10:12-13

*“See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil,
in that I command you today to love Yahuah your Elohim,
to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments,
His statutes, and His judgments, that you may live and multiply;
and Yahuah your Elohim will bless you in the land which you go to possess.”*

Deuteronomy 30:15-16

This is His standard.

This is how we love Him.

To walk in His ways and keep His commandments, statutes, and judgments.

***The greatest commandment is to love our Father and
if you don't love Him according to the way He has proclaimed you will be rejected.***

If you do not keep His commandments & not walk in His ways, you do not love Him.
You actually hate Him!

““Therefore know that Yahuah your Elohim, He is Elohim,
the faithful El who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations
with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
and He repays those who hate Him to their face, to destroy them.
He will not be slack with him who hates Him;
He will repay him to his face.
Therefore you shall keep the commandment, the statutes, and the judgments
which I command you today, to observe them.”
Deuteronomy 7:9-11

Those who do not love Him and Keep His commandments
He is going to repay them and destroy them and
that’s why keeping the Torah is so important.
He promises to repay and destroy all who hate Him

The answer to not being one who hates Him is
To keep His commandments

prophesied that Yahuah is our God and it is Him that we will know to be our God.*

TORAH

“I will take you as My people, and I will be your God.
Then you shall know that I am Yahuah your God who brings you out
from under the burdens of the Egyptians.”
Exodus 6:7

“And they shall know that I am Yahuah their God,
who brought them up out of the land of Egypt,
that I may dwell among them.
I am Yahuah their God.
Exodus 29:46

"But from there you will seek Yahuah your God,
and you will find Him if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul.
When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days,
when you turn to Yahuah your God and obey His voice
(for Yahuah your God is a merciful God),
He will not forsake you nor destroy you,
nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them."
Deuteronomy 4:29-31

PROPHECY

Their nobles shall be from among them,
And their governor shall come from their midst;
Then I will cause him to draw near,
And he shall approach Me;

Jeremiah 30:21-22

Jeremiah 31:33

He will be our God and we will be His people.

""Then say to them,
'Thus says Yahuah Elohim:
"Surely I will take the children of Israel from among the nations,
wherever they have gone,
and will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land;
and I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel;
and one king shall be king over them all;
they shall no longer be two nations,
nor shall they ever be divided into two kingdoms again.
They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols,
nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions;
but I will deliver them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned,
and will cleanse them.
Then they shall be My people, and I will be their God."
Ezekiel 37:21-23

It is prophesied against us that if we did not serve Him as our God,
he Will punish us and we will serve other gods.

“You shall be left few in number,
whereas you were as the stars of heaven in multitude,
because you would not obey the voice of Yahuah your God.

And it shall be,

that just as Yahuah rejoiced over you to do you good and multiply you,
so Yahuah will rejoice over you to destroy you and bring you to nothing;
and you shall be plucked from off the land which you go to possess.

Then Yahuah will scatter you among all peoples,
from one end of the earth to the other,
and there you shall serve other gods,
which neither you nor your fathers have known—wood and stone.”

Deuteronomy 28:62-64

When we didn't serve Him, He rejoiced over our destruction.
And He destroyed us and cursed us for not loving Him.

*Christianity represents loving Yahuah by default
We must love Yahuah with our whole heart, soul, mind, & strength.*
