

HOW TO BE HOLY

We all say it that we should be *holy*.
But many of us, don't know what that even means.
We all say, we want to be set apart, but for many of us, we don't apply it.

YAHUAH chose Israel for a reason and if you come to YAHUAH through Yahusha you are grafted into Israel and therefore you have the same purpose Israel has.

We are called to be a called out, a set apart nation or body of people and as we go into this new season, we all must take this seriously and make this the major part of our faith.

The Hebrew word for Holy is **Qodesh**
To be holy is to be Qodesh.
Qodesh means to be consecrated or special or simply Set Apart
To be Holy is to Be Set Apart to be called out

“EVERY TIME YOU SEE “HOLY” IT MEANS “SET APART””

“But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a *holy* nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of Elohim, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.”

Scriptures About Being Saints

The Hebrew word for saints is **Qodeshim**.
This goes back to the Hebrew word for Holy
Qodesh which again means Set Apart.
Qodeshim means Set Apart Ones

To be a Saint is to be a Set Apart One
